# 5. ATTACHING THE BATTERY PACK

#### Follow the order $(\mathbf{0} \sim \mathbf{2})$ in the illustration below.





Even when the transceiver's power is OFF, a small current still flows in the transceiver. Remove the battery pack when not using it for a long time. Otherwise, the battery will become exhausted.

**NOTE:** Turn OFF the power before remove the battery pack in order  $(\mathbf{0} \sim \mathbf{2})$  in the illustration to the right.



# 6. CHARGING TIME AND OPERATING TIME

# 7. CHARGING THE BATTERY PACK (Using the BC-202IP2)

Fully charge the battery pack when the first time of use or has not been used for more than 2 months.

WARNING! NEVER charge the transceiver during a lightning storm. It may result in an electric shock, cause a fire or damage the transceiver. Always disconnect the power adapter before a storm.

- Turn OFF the transceiver power before charging.
- Otherwise, the battery may not be fully charged. Insert the transceiver (battery attached to the transceiver)
